
(Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC)

The organization explicitly states that it has read and understood the “Policy for the association of Organization with FSC” as published under www.fsc.org. This Policy stipulates FSC’s position with regards to unacceptable activities by organization and individuals which already are or would like to be associated with FSC as well as the mechanism for disassociation.

In light of the above, the Organization explicitly agree currently and in the future, as long as the relation with FSC exists, not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- Illegal harvesting or illegal trade in forest products;
- Violation of customary or human rights within the forestry or forest products sector;
- Violation of workers right and principles defined in the International Labour Organization (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work within the forestry or forest products sector;
- Destruction of High Conservation Values (HCVs) in forest or High Conservation Value areas;
- Conversion of natural forest cover;
- Use of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations for any other purposes than research.
